NHS dental charges from 24 April 2023

The charge you pay depends on the treatment you need to keep your mouth, gums and teeth healthy. You will only ever be asked to pay one charge for each complete course of treatment, even if you need to visit your dentist more than once to finish it – either Band 1. Band 2 or Band 3.

If you are not exempt from charges, you should pay one of the following charges for each course of treatment you receive:

Band 1 course of treatment — £25.80

This covers an examination, diagnosis (eg X-rays), advice on how to prevent future problems, a scale and polish if needed, and application of fluoride varnish or fissure sealant. If you require urgent care, even if your urgent treatment needs more than one appointment to complete, you will only need to pay one Band 1 charge.

Band 2 course of treatment — £70.70

This covers everything listed in Band 1 above, plus any further treatment such as fillings, root canal work or if your dentist needs to take out one or more of your teeth.

Band 3 course of treatment — £306.80

This covers everything listed in Bands 1 and 2 above, plus crowns, dentures and bridges.

Free NHS dental treatment or help with health costs

You may be eligible for help with all or part of the costs of your NHS dental treatment. Are you claiming free treatment?

Don't assume you're entitled. You could have to pay **up to £100** - as well as the original treatment charge.

Who can claim free NHS dental care?

You're entitled to free treatment if you are:

- √ under 18 years old
- ✓ aged 18 and in full-time education
- ✓ pregnant or have given birth in the 12 months before your treatment starts
- ✓ included in a claim for **certain benefits** turn over for more information
- ✓ covered by an HC2 or HC2W certificate for full help with health costs
- ✓ included in an award of:
 - Child Tax Credit
 - Working Tax Credit including a disability element
 - Child Tax Credit and Working Tax Credit paid together

and your annual family income used to work out your tax credits is **£15.276** or less.

If you meet these conditions, you will normally be sent an NHS Tax Credit Exemption Certificate which is valid for up to 7 months.

If you live in Wales, you're entitled to a free examination if you're under 25 or 60 or over.



Who can claim reduced cost NHS dental care?

You may get help with dental treatment charges if you have an HC3 or HC3W certificate for partial help with health costs. Your certificate tells you how much you have to pay.
